Investment Objective

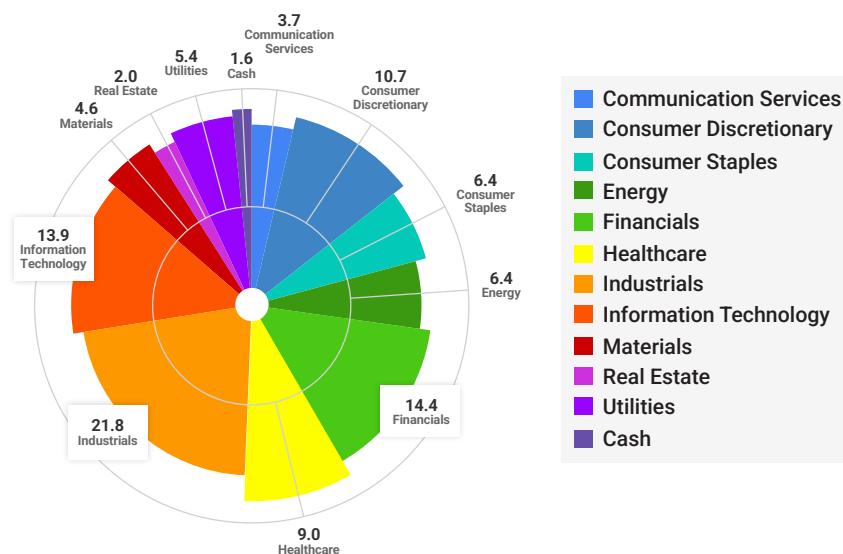
The Hilton Small-MidCap Opportunity ETF (“the Fund”) seeks long-term capital appreciation by investing in small and mid-US equity securities.

Investment Strategy

Utilizing the Hilton Capital Management, LLC proprietary Small & Mid Cap Opportunities investment process (“SMCO process”) the Fund seeks to identify stocks whose current market prices do not accurately reflect the managers’ estimate of their fundamental earnings potential.

While the “SMCO process” is value oriented this actively managed Fund seeks to invest in equities throughout the spectrum encompassing value, growth and core stocks. The manager believes that this investment approach can help identify potentially attractive investment ideas in different stages of the economic cycle.

Portfolio volatility is managed across several parameters including valuations, business fundamentals, position size, sector and industry exposure, and factor-based considerations are constantly monitored to manage portfolio volatility and risk profile.
